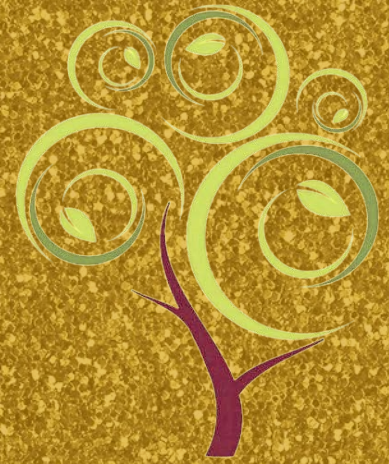

Dear Friends,

Well, we did it! **In 2022, our first post-pandemic year of “normalcy,”** we raised the roof and exceeded our goal of \$200,000 to replace our 65,000 square foot roof. For the first time in two years, we hosted the return of **“Breakfast with the Bishop,”** our popular fundraiser at the Detroit Athletic Club, and our annual **Candlelight Dinner** where we invite families in to celebrate the holidays at St. Anne’s Mead.

2022 was a year of turning the corner and seeing the light.

We are grateful to you for being a faithful supporter. As a small, mission-driven, non-profit organization, you make it possible for us to rise to the occasion of many challenges. Families turn to St. Anne’s Mead for the people, the care, and the home-like atmosphere.

While we are certainly unique, we recognize that we are in a highly competitive environment with several Assisted Living facilities, many of which are in brand new buildings. That is why our current capital improvements project is refreshing the Assisted Living rooms, to help us make a fresh first impression on potential new family members. Part of this includes installing more walk-in showers for the safety and convenience of our residents.

To help qualifying residents with the cost of care, we also began participating in the PACE (Program of All Inclusive Care) Program of Southeast Michigan. This is a very promising partnership and one that helps us meet the needs of current and future residents who are eligible for the program.

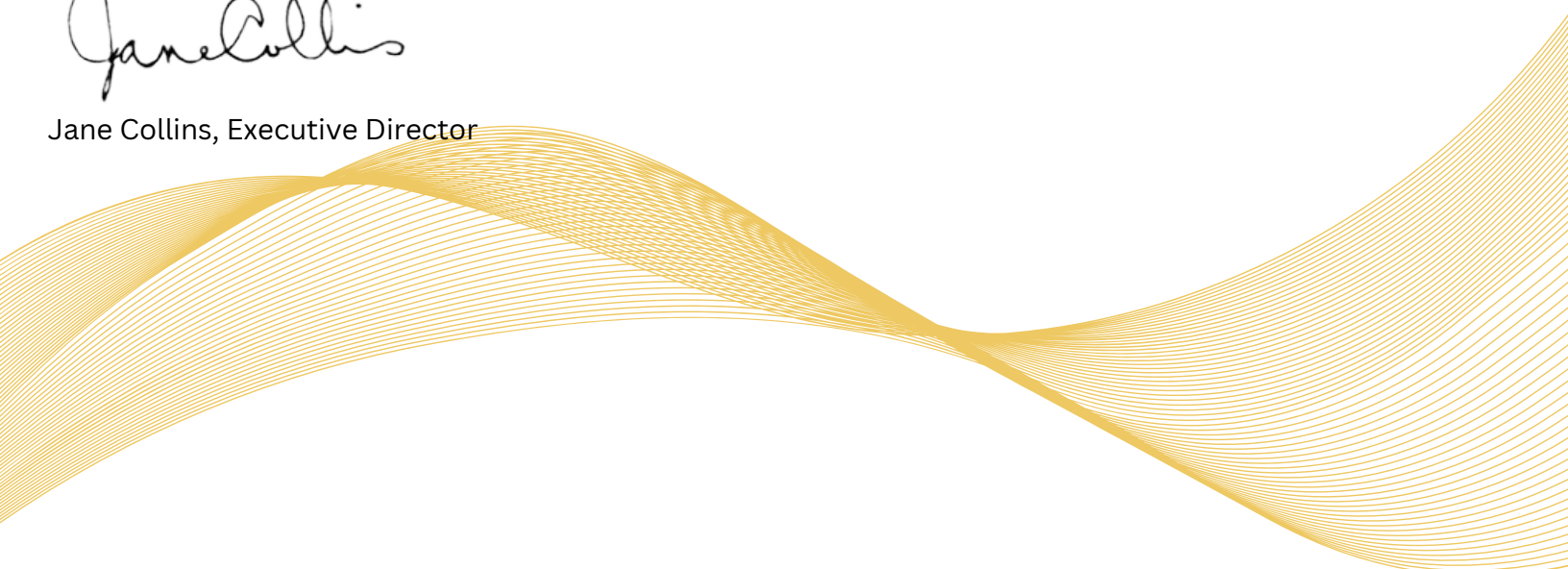
Our **Angel Fund** continues to subsidize residents facing economic hardship, often at the end of life.

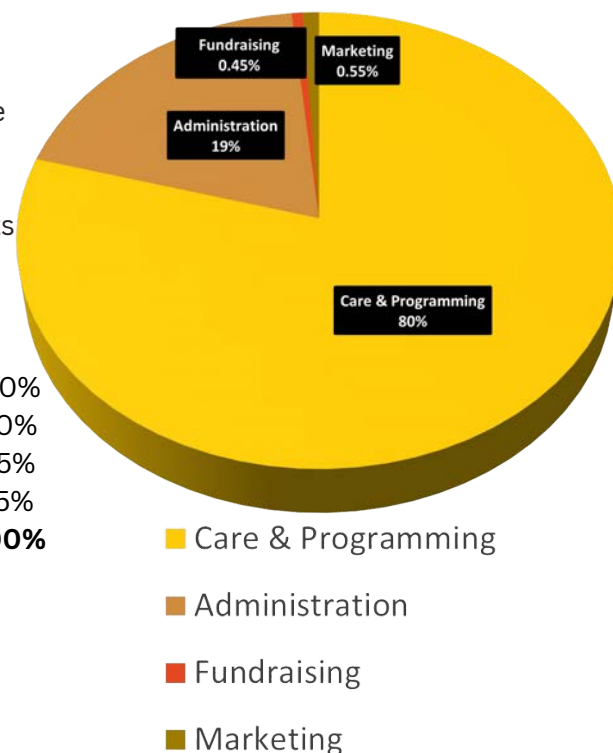
